**Workshop on State Regulations and Grant Funding to Clean Up Diesel Engines**  
**May 14 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon**

On May 14, 2009 the San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District is hosting a diesel training seminar to provide information to fleet operators on State regulations, local issues and grant funds available for eligible projects. Over \$600,000 is available in grant funding on a first-come, first-serve basis for On-Road, Off-Road and Agricultural projects based in the County that voluntarily reduce air pollution. These projects can also assist fleet owners with early compliance of State regulations.

The training seminar will cover an overview of State Regulations and local issues impacting Agricultural Engines, Off-Road Equipment and On-Road Trucks. California Air Resources Board staff will be presenting on the State's regulations and SLO County Air Pollution Control District staff will discuss local issues, grant funding, and eligible projects.

The workshop will have three sections – Stationary and Portable Agricultural Engines, Off-Road Engines, and On-Road Vehicles. Each section will provide participants an opportunity to ask questions specific to their fleet operations. In addition to speakers, engine and retrofit dealers will be displaying information on technologies that can assist fleet operators in meeting the State's requirements.
